University Students Capstone Projects

Each year, dozens of manufacturing companies present engineering schools in Connecticut universities with design challenges or problems they are encountering in their business. The students research and analyze the problem, and typically end up with a solution---a design, a model, a working prototype. Ideally, it's a win-win for the company and the students: the company gets a problem solved they haven't had resources to address, and the student gets a real issue to solve.

In addition, manufacturers get to meet engineering faculty and students, and students learn about Connecticut manufacturers. Costs to the company are modest. The array of technical disciplines range over mechanical, materials, civil, industrial, Cybersecurity, computer science, and engineering management.

CONNSTEP will coordinate the connection between the manufacturer and the university.
