- Cybersecurity Primary concerns are: 1) lack of awareness, 2) lack of understanding, and
 3) lack of strategic priority.
 - Raising awareness cybersecurity is broadly applicable and not just for defense manufacturers
- SIRI assessment Primary concerns are: 1) lack of awareness and 2) lack of strategic priority.
 - o Federal government has yet to release mandates regarding CMMC
 - o CONNSTEP is exploring a SIRI alternative
