

Disabled Veterans' Outreach & Local Veterans' Employment

The WorkPlace conducts comprehensive planning, and coordination of regional and state-wide workforce development programs to prepare people for careers while strengthening the workforce for employers.

The WorkPlace administers workforce development funds and the coordination of both job training and education programs. Their main role, however, is much larger. They believe in the power of ideas to affect great change – so they act as convener, catalyst, collaborator and advocate for workforce development across the region, state and nation.



PROGRAM DETAILS

Disabled Veterans' Outreach Program (DVOP) Provide intensive, individualized career services for veterans and eligible spouses who face significant barriers to employment.

Local Veterans' Employment Representatives (LVER) Conduct outreach to the employer community; facilitating employment, training, and placement services under the state's employment service.

LVER's promote the HIRE Vets Medallion Program, assisting local area employers to apply for award when appropriate.
